1. Purpose of Processing.

3. Data Retention Period.

Typically, course participant data is retained for a period of three years after course completion to comply with accreditation requirements and for audit purposes.

4. Rights of Data Subjects.

You have several rights under GDPR, including the right to access your personal data, request correction or erasure of your personal data, and object to or restrict processing. You also have the right to data portability, allowing you to receive your data in a structured, commonly used format or transfer it to another controller.
